11 WHEREAS Attacks by the Trump administration are affecting the environment in which  
12 we work and study (i.e. Executive Orders targeting Muslims & immigrants,<sup>1</sup> Attempting  
13 to repeal the Affordable Care Act,<sup>2</sup> Limiting external communication from the  
14 Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the Department of Health and Human  
15 Services (HHS),<sup>3</sup> Curtailing research funding by cutting the budgets of the National  
16 Institutes of Health (NIH)<sup>4</sup>, Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), National Oceanic  
17 and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA), and Department of Energy (DOE),<sup>5</sup>  
18 Approving the Keystone XL and Dakota Access oil pipelines,<sup>6</sup> Attacking transgender  
19 rights,<sup>7</sup> Planning to defund the National Endowment for the Arts (NEA) and the National  
20 Endowment for the Humanities (NEH)<sup>8</sup>, and appointing an unqualified individual, hostile  
21 to public education, to serve as Secretary of Education.<sup>9</sup>); and

23 WHEREAS the City of Seattle has already taken a strong position on declaring itself a  
24 sanctuary city and committing to non-cooperation with federal immigration authorities;<sup>10</sup>

27 WHEREAS UAW 4121 (representing 4,000 student workers at the University of  
28 Washington) as well as numerous faith, immigrant rights, environmental, and labor  
29 organizations, have pledged to participate in May 1<sup>st</sup> Day of Action and Resistance,  
30 through actions including strikes, walkouts, and teach-ins; and the Martin Luther King  
31 County Labor Council have passed resolutions supporting May 1<sup>st</sup> as a Day of Action and  
32 Resistance, including strikes, walkouts, and teach-ins;<sup>11</sup> and
