

Article 21 – Parking and Transit

Section 1. ASEs shall have the option to participate in the on-campus parking program. ASEs shall have the same parking related services that are available to, and on the same basis as, full-time staff of the University. These parking related services include but are not limited to quarterly parking permits.

Section 2. Notice. At sites operated by the University Transportation Services Department, the Union will have the option to bargain the impacts of any changes to parking access policy that will affect bargaining unit employees. This does not include parking rate increases, parking payment automation, increases/decreases in the number of parking spaces or any and all changes related to student parking.

Section 3. U-PASS. Eligible bargaining unit employees will not be charged a fee for a U-PASS through Spring Quarter 2027. Starting summer quarter 2025 and during summer quarters only, non-registered ASEs outlined in Article 25 will not be charged a fee for a U-PASS.
